Section 11, Article 4.7, Part C

Add: Attendants; "Once the vehicle enters the lineup, the attendant must exit the vehicle to assist the entry in the lineup."

Delete: Headers

Proposed Rule change:

C. Attendants

1. Are allowed but must come from within the vehicle. This means no outside assistance.

3. Once the vehicle enters the lineup, the attendant must exit the vehicle to assist the entry in the lineup.

Justification:

This clarification provides safety and guidance to those entries participating in the carriage classes.
