**Section 10, Article 4.8, Part 0, #3**

**Delete:** "Ponies one year and older..."

**Proposed Rule Change:**

1. Ponies one year and older can show barefoot or with plain shoes of light weight, no pad, no caulks, no weights of any kind shall be permitted. Shoes shall be plain plates. No toe shoes, tapered shoes or recessed shoes will be allowed.

**Justification:**

Certain yearling ponies may need to be shod due to soft hooves.
