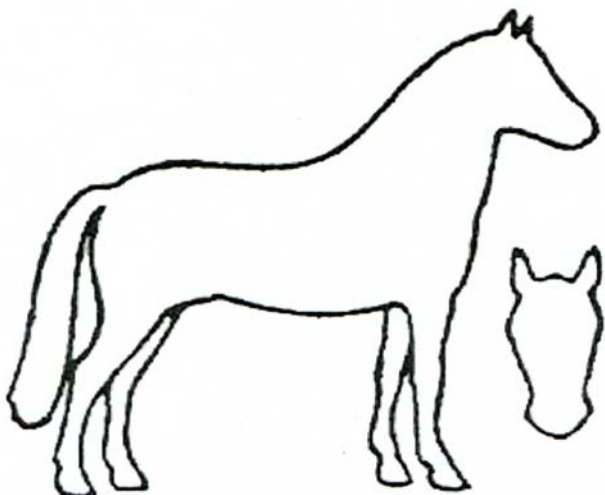

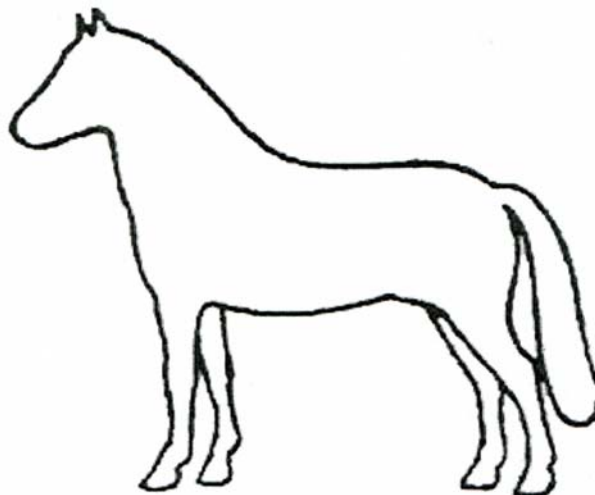

## INSTRUCTIONS FOR COMPLETING REGISTRATION APPLICATION

**Remember** – The information contained on this application will be used as documentation for the registration certificate. **BE SURE YOU ARE CORRECT** on the spelling of all names, registration numbers, the foaling date, and the accurate description of the animal. Any corrections requested after the horse is registered will incur correction fees and possibly require DNA proof.

1. Current owner of Dam at time of foaling will be original registered owner of foal. Complete address of current owner(s) listed above. To change or add owner, a separate transfer must accompany registration.
2. **APPLICATION MUST BE SIGNED** by owner(s) **of the dam at the time of foaling**. All owners of the dam must sign if there is an “and” between the owner names, only one signature required if “or” is used.
3. **HORSE OR FOAL’S DATE OF BIRTH**
4. **HEIGHT** (if horse has reached its actual 3<sup>rd</sup> birthday **ONLY**—it would then qualify to be registered as permanent) Measure from the last hair of the mane to the bottom of the hoof.
5. **SELECT TWO NAME CHOICES** and **MARK** “Yes” or “No” as to whether or not AMHR can select if neither can be used. If neither selection can be used, and “No” is marked, the work will be returned to you for another selection. **Name selection is limited to 35 (thirty-five) letters, spaces and punctuation marks (fewer the better)**
6. **SELECT GENDER** – If “Gelding” is chosen, you **MUST** enclose a **Gelding Certificate** signed by the surgeon who performed the surgery or statement from a veterinarian stating that the animal is indeed a gelding without testicles.
7. **SIRE NAME AND REGISTRATION NUMBER**—must be currently registered with the AMHR
8. **DAM NAME AND REGISTRATION NUMBER**—must be currently registered with the AMHR  
**\*\* SIRE OR DAM CANNOT HAVE EXPIRED CERTIFICATES\*\***
9. **COLOR OF FOAL OR HORSE BEING REGISTERED** **\*\*--** Please be specific and use accepted equine colors – The circling of “dapple”, “roan”, “pinto” or “appaloosa” **require a base color**.  
**\*\*The AMHR reserves the right to change the color submitted on applications as it deems necessary\*\***

BAY -- Chestnut or sorrel with black mane & tail and black points

SILVER BAY – Bay with flaxen or silver mane & tail and black points

BLACK – Black with mane & tail black

BROWN -- Sometimes difficult to distinguish from black or dark bay, but can be decided by taking careful notice of the fine hairs on the muzzle, must have brown mane and tail

BUCKSKIN/ DUN -- Black mane & tail and usually black points; often has a dorsal stripe

CHESTNUT -- Dark mahogany red or dark reddish-brown; mane & tail usually same color, may be flaxen

CREMELLO – Cream, must have pink skin and blue eyes, mane & tail same color

DUN -- Dominant hair is some shade of yellow from mouse color to golden; mane & tail may be lighter or darker than body; often has dorsal stripe.

GREY -- Some greys are born blue or almost black with more white hairs appearing with age until nearly white

GRULLO -- Smooth grayish-blue color like a mouse-not a blue roan-always has black mane & tail, usually black lower legs

BLUE ROAN – Bluish-black color intermingled with white, head darker than body with black legs, mane & tail

PALOMINO --Bright gold or off-white color, black skin, white mane & tail

ROAN -- Produced by intermingling of white hairs with any color

SORREL --Reddish or copper-red coat, mane & tail usually same color, may be flaxen

10. **COLOR OF MANE AND TAIL**
11. **INDICATE FACE AND LEG MARKINGS** –markings will be adjusted according to AMHR standards.
12. **BREEDER** – Name and address of the **PERSON(S) OWNING THE DAM** at the time of breeding or service
13. **STALLION SERVICE CERTIFICATE** – **required only** when the person registering the foal/horse was not the owner of **both the sire and the dam** at the time of service or breeding. Attach service certificate to application.
14. **If you wish to have photos incorporated on the front of your certificate, you must submit four color photos: a full frontal, a full rear, a right side and a left, on in which the horse has his head turned toward the camera to show the front of the face.** All four legs must be seen from both sides; markings on face must be visible. All photos should include all parts of the animal available in that view (ears to hooves or nose to tail inclusive) and be unobstructed by any other object or animal. Photos must be a minimum of 3” X 5” and a maximum of 4 X 6”. Label each photo with first choice of name and owner’s name on the back. **IF YOU DO NOT SEND PHOTOS, the HORSE’S MARKINGS MUST BE RECORDED AND DRAWN IN ON THE TEMPLATE provided for certificate incorporation or it will have to be returned.**
15. **STALLION SERVICE BREEDING REPORT MUST BE ON FILE** – Stallion owners must file a service report in the AMHR office by January 15<sup>th</sup> following each breeding season. Those reports postmarked after January 15<sup>th</sup> and all amended reports will be charged \$25.

**APPLICANT PLEASE NOTE** – By your signature, you are certifying that the information submitted on this document is true and correct to your knowledge and that you agree to abide by the rules set forth by the ASPC/AMHR/ASPR. If there is ever a question about the age of this animal, you must have said animal inspected and/or mouthed to verify age.
