



Supreme Amateur Awards: ASPC/ASPR Ponies; AMHR Miniature Horses

Award Description: The Supreme Amateur Awards are given each year for the overall high point ASPC/ASPR pony and to the overall high point AMHR horse. These two awards are based on All Star points earned during the show year ending December 31; the awards are presented the following year at the national convention. Points from all amateur classes count towards this award.

Criteria and Details:

- There are two Supreme Amateur Awards, one for ASPC/ASPR ponies and one for AMHR horses. These are earned by the overall high point amateur shown ASPC/ASPR pony and by the overall high point amateur shown AMHR miniature horse.
- The supreme pony and supreme miniature horse must have achieved points in all three disciplines: conformation halter; driving; and performance. Points from all amateur classes count toward the award.
- Rule Book provisions apply (multiple amateurs for ponies; amateur must own or lease miniature horses).
- Points are calculated by the association office electronically using All Star points.

These awards may be modified on an annual basis in the discretion of the Board of Directors and/or the Amateur Committee. Changes will be posted to the web site prior to commencement of the show year.
