Due January 1st of the Current Convention Year

Proposed Rule Changes to be brought before the National Convention must be sent to the Director of Operations to send to the Rules Committee who will review the submissions for duplication, clarity and conflict with existing rules.

All submissions must be postmarked on or before January 1 of the current Convention year so that they may go through the appropriate process and be able to be printed in the October issue of The Journal. All items **MUST BE** submitted on the following proposal form. All copies must be signed and must include the submitter's ASPC/AMHR membership number.

~~Delete: 8. Course diagrams are to show each jump with arrows showing which direction it is to be taken. Exhibitors determine the optimum path to take to get from one jump to the next. Exhibitors may take any path, as long as they stay within the course boundaries and do not jump any jumps out of order.~~

Replace with: Course diagrams must show the order each jump is to be taken, arrows showing the direction each must be taken, and markers or a line to indicate the start and finish of the course.

1.1 General Class Rules C. All Obstacle, Jumping and Hunter Classes 2. Course diagrams must show the order each obstacle/jump is to be taken (obstacle/jump number), arrows showing the direction each must be taken, and markers or a line to indicate the start and finish of the course

Other reasons:

Exhibitors all need to take the course in the same direction, following a numbered order of jumps to allow the presentations to be identical from one exhibitor to the next.

Consulting with individuals currently showing and training hunter/jumpers, I confirmed that numbered order of jumps on patterned courses continues to be standard practice in hunter/jumper competitions and there are no classes with choice of jump order.
