



## Nationals Amateur High Point Awards: AMHR

**Award Description:** The award is based on the miniature horse and amateur combination that garners the most points in amateur classes listed below. The miniature horse is limited to a single amateur exhibitor recorded and in accordance with the Rule Book.

**How Awards are Calculated:** Winners are calculated using a weighted point system based on number of horses in the class for each class in which the miniature horse/exhibitor is entered.

### To Qualify:

- Exhibitor must be a current member in good standing;
- Each amateur class will count;
- Handler/Driver must meet qualifications/requirements for amateur exhibition of a miniature horse as set forth in the Rule Book.

### Divisions:

- Miniature Horse “Under”:
  - Halter (conformation halter in-hand)
  - Performance
    - Driving (all amateur classes regardless of description)
    - Obstacle in-hand
    - Obstacle driving
    - Showmanship
    - Hunter
    - Jumper
    - Versatility
    - Costume
    - Chariot
  - Other classes as added over time to (amateur) class list per Board of Directors
- Miniature Horse “Over”:
  - Halter (conformation halter in-hand)
  - Performance
    - Driving (all amateur classes regardless of description)
    - Obstacle in-hand
    - Obstacle driving
    - Showmanship
    - Hunter
    - Jumper
    - Versatility
    - Chariot
    - Costume
  - Other classes as added over time to (amateur) class list per Board of Directors
- Golden Age: All Golden Age classes to count. Award is a combined award for “under” and “over” miniature horses.

These awards may be modified on an annual basis in the discretion of the Board of Directors and/or the Amateur Committee. Changes will be posted to the web site prior to AMHR Nationals.
