E. Rule change proposals are discussed within their appropriate Committee prior to the ASPC/AMHR/ASPR National Convention; held in November. Rules are then brought to the Convention for discussion during Committee meetings. Rules that are passed during the Convention Committee meetings are then sent to the Board of Directors, who will review discuss any requests for extraordinary rules and those merits.

F. Rules passed during Convention (other than those requests for Extraordinary Changes) **do not go into effect until the year following the spring Board of Directors meeting where the Board of Directors will review.**

G. When a rule is changed it must remain unchanged for a period of three years from time of implementation. Exceptions: the rule is deemed unsafe, detrimental or a gross unfairness to the ASPC/AMHR/ASPR and its membership.
