Tack and Equipment-AMHR

1. Light Harness (breast or collar type)
2. To be shown in a suitable two or four wheeled carriage pleasure type driving vehicle. Wooden wheels are preferred, Solid Spoke or Steel wheels are acceptable, Pneumatic wheels permitted, Boot removed
3. Type of bit(s) optional, Snaffle, Liverpool's, French link, Mullen, Butterfly or Myler are acceptable driving bits. Curb chains or Curb straps are allowed and can only be driven in the half cheek. Blinkers appropriate to type of harness
4. Martingales and overchecks are prohibited for all vehicles. False Martingales are acceptable.
5. Side checks are optional, breeching or thimbles are required. Tying down of tongues is prohibited. Bridles should fit snugly to prevent catching on the vehicle or other pieces of harness. A throatlatch and a noseband or cavesson is mandatory. Open bridles are permitted but are not encouraged.
6. Whip required. The thong (lash) of the whip should be long enough to reach the shoulder of the farther horse.
7. Braiding of mane and forelock is optional in any carriage driving class.
8. Spares Kits are optional
