Continued....In all other breeds Hunters do NOT jump gradient heights. It defeats the purpose of showing a smooth presentation and can discourage new exhibitors, and the smaller horses from competing. I believe the original intend was max height for the jumpers but it was placed in the wrong paragraph.
