

Congress Amateur High Point Awards: ASPC & ASPR

Award Description: These awards are given in two categories: Classic/Foundation; and Modern/Modern Pleasure/ASPR. In each, the award is based on the pony that garners the most points in amateur classes listed below. The pony may have multiple amateur exhibitors.

How Awards are Calculated: Winners are calculated using a weighted point system based on number of horses in the class for each class in which the pony is entered.

To Qualify:

- Exhibitor must be a current member in good standing;
- Each amateur class will count;
- Multiple exhibitors are acceptable.

Divisions:

- Classic/Foundation
 - Halter (conformation halter in-hand)
 - Performance
 - Driving (all amateur classes regardless of description)
 - Obstacle in-hand
 - Obstacle driving
 - Showmanship
 - Hunter
 - Jumper
 - Other classes as added over time to (amateur) class list per Board of Directors
- Modern/Modern Pleasure/ASPR
 - Halter (conformation halter in-hand)
 - Performance
 - Driving (all amateur classes regardless of description)
 - Showmanship
 - Other classes as added over time to (amateur) class list per Board of Directors

These awards may be modified on an annual basis in the discretion of the Board of Directors and/or the Amateur Committee. Changes will be posted to the web site prior to Congress.
