7. Classic Pleasure and Classic Formal Pleasure ponies cannot cross-enter into Country Pleasure Driving classes at the same show.
8. Country Pleasure ponies cannot cross enter into Classic Formal Pleasure or Classic Pleasure classes at the same show.
9. Driving whips (optional) if used must be of suitable style, and the tip of the lash must not reach past the shoulder of the pony.
10. Drivers and their attendants should be dressed appropriately. Hats, gloves, and aprons are optional. No strapless tops or open toed shoes allowed.
11. Performance classes are open to Classic and Foundation Classic Shetlands.
12. Only the animal(s) entered in a performance class is allowed in the ring during judging.
13. Classics may be shown barefoot or with a light plate of uniform thickness and weight. **No pads are permitted.** No built up feet or heel measurements exceeding 1 $\frac{3}{4}$ " allowed. No weighted shoes or shoes having toe or side clips, grabs, caulks, or trailers. The plate shall be of equal length in the branches from the toe back and shall not extend past the bulb of the heel. No corrective shoeing will be permitted.
14. Stake classes will be known as Championship classes. 1st place will be Champion and 2nd place will be Reserve Champion.

4.2 Pleasure Driving Division

- A. The Classic Pleasure Shetland must exhibit Classic conformation standards, quiet manners, perform at a collected gait on a light rein, stand quietly and back readily. Extreme action or heavy on the bit will be penalized.
